This is an interesting project indeed, but it must be carefully thought out, bearing in mind the positives and negatives. I for one, am strongly opposed to the proposed location, because of the presence of nearby Academie de la Seigneurie. Traffic is already very dense, especially on Promenade des Érables, des Pommiers rd, and des Épinettes rd. Definitely more so in the morning before school, during noon hour and after school. Promenade des Érables traffic is almost halting to a stop before and after school, with students, school buses, and local traffic trying to make their way. At other times, traffic on des Érables is very fast, much faster than the required 50 km/h. Establishing a community garden in the proposed greenspace would result in increased parked vehicles on these three roads, especially close to the three entrances to the greenspace; more parked vehicles resuling in an increased risk of accidents to our walking school population during these high traffic hours. Please lets have our students in mind when we make this important decision. That particular greenspace is also a thing of beauty. It has been very well thought out by our previous councils, and the present council is doing a wonderful job at its grooming and regular maintenance. What a joy it is to look at, walk through or simply relaxing at one of the picnic tables, as some of our students do during their noon hour. Let us not detract them from doing so. I welcome Erin and her comittee to continue this wonderful entrepreneurial endeavor, and wish them success at finding a more suitable location.
