EXEMPTION FROM PART LOT CONTROL BY-LAW MUNICIPALITY OF CASSELMAN BY-LAW NO. 2019-XXX

"Being a By-law to exempt certain lands from Part Lot Control, in Registered Plan H.O.WOOD 1885, on a Street legally named MONTCALM STREET, in the Municipality of Casselman and in the County of Russell."

WHEREAS pursuant to the written request from Chantal Georgette Brisson, dated August 15, 2019, it is expedient to exempt from Part Lot Control certain lands being PT LT EC PL H.O.WOOD 1885; PT LT 10 CON 6, on a Street legally named Montcalm Street;

WHEREAS the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13, as amended, (the "Planning Act") subsection 50(5) provides that all lands within a plan of subdivision are subject to part lot control;

WHEREAS authority is vested in Council of municipalities by the Planning Act, subsection 50(7) to enact by-laws which provide that subsection 50(5) does not apply to lands that are within a registered plan of subdivision as are designated in the by-law;

AND WHEREAS the Planning Act, subsection 50(7.1) does not come into effect until approved by the United Counties of Prescott and Russell;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CASSELMAN ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT PT LT EC PL H.O. WOOD 1885; PT LT 10 CON 6, PART 1 on REGISTERED PLAN 50R3160, in the Municipality of Casselman, County of Russell, (PIN 69022-0134) as shown on Schedule "A" attached hereto, is/are hereby exempted from Part lot Control pursuant to subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act.
- 2. THAT this By-law comes into force and effect when it is approved by the United Counties of Prescott and Russell.
- 3. THAT this by-law shall not be construed as to permit the further resubdivision or severance of any such parcel.
- 4. Registration of this by-law in the proper land registry office is authorized and this by-law shall thereupon become effective.
